Current Positions Available for 2018:

Laser Race Team Coach, 20 hours per week, Feb to November. Must be able to travel to Grand Prix Events (Laser.org) and all BC Circuit events (bcsailing.bc.ca). Must have Standard First Aid with CPR-C, PCOC, familiarity with competing nationally and/or internationally. Training costs will be reimbursed.

All levels of CANSail coaches who have a passion for sailing and enjoy passing that on to others. Work is available for all levels of CANSail coaches for LTS camps running Mondays through Fridays, end of June to the end of August. Must have Standard First Aid with CPR-C, PCOC, and coach boat safety. Course and pre-requisite costs will be reimbursed based upon the number of weeks you work during the summer.

Schools program instructors. Each year we host elementary and high school kids for day sailing. These field trips run Monday to Friday from the end of April to the end of June. Must have Standard First Aid with CPR-C, PCOC, familiarity with either Optimists or FJs or preferably both. Training costs will be reimbursed.

Paddle board and Kayaking instructors. Running from July to the end of August our Multi Activity program consists of paddle boarding, kayaking and sailing in a non-stressed setting so kids don't have to think about whether they will pass or not. Must have Standard First Aid with CPR-C, PCOC, familiarity with either paddle boarding or kayaking or preferably both. Training costs will be reimbursed.
