Hi John,

I looked over your submission for the PHRF BC Fall Appeals and wanted to touch base as your Club's representative to the PHRF BC Handicappers Committee.

Your current base boat rating is a "T" rating - an initial assignment that has yet to be ratified by the Handicappers Committee. It will be reviewed during the Fall Handicappers Meeting (held just prior to the Appeals session) and your submission will be added to the information for consideration. A permanent Base Boat Rating will then be assigned.

If you are still inclined to follow through with an appeal - but we don't know what rating will apply - then you will need to submit race results from at least one active season. If you have any race results for the San Diego boat that may help as well although it will be argued that the BC Handicappers Committee has no insight into the competence of it's crew/equipment set up/sail age. Another item that may work against you is the fact that your sails are vintage.

My suggestion to you in this situation is to let me take your information to the Committee for your "T" review and let's see what permanent rating comes out of it. Then if you still want to pursue this follow through with your appeal in the spring, remembering that the primary focus of the Committee is race results.
