Mark anchors

The below is a bit detailed, need enough ground tackle to hold in the conditions, and some spares in case of loss

Anchors

1 per mark, plus several spares.

Chain

Recommend 10ft of 3/8 for each anchor line

Shackles

Recommend several per anchor line

Anchor line

Recommend enough for 2-1 scope on each mark

Lunches / water for all volunteers

Radios VHF

The signal boat two handhelds or one hand held and a ships radio

Each mark boat one handheld or ships radio

Jury one handheld for each jury boat

Race flag poles

Each of the primary flags should be on 8 ft poles or halyards for the signal boat and on 6ft poles for mark boats. See details below under flags.

One good gimmick is to have sponsor flags for the Start line Flags instead of Orange.

Air horn w/canisters

Several horns on the mark boat, one horn each for the mark boats. Have spare canisters.
Insure the horns and canisters are compatible.
